Historical Collection 28: The Harry Neitz Sermons

INTRODUCTION

The Harry Neitz Sermons include sermon outlines, full-text sermons, and sermon notes without outlines written by Rev. Neitz during his ministry. The documents are handwritten in the English language, but the collection contains twelve German language sermons as well. Harry was the son of Solomon Neitz, a famous Evangelical preacher who was considered "the most eloquent orator" of the German language in America during his lifetime. Two of the sermons are ascribed to the Rev. Solomon Neitz. The sermons in the collection were preached on multiple dates and at multiple locations, presumably by Harry, according to notations on the documents.

These sermons were given to the Rev. W.E. Pottieger (see related collection HC-88) during his pastorate in Millersburg, PA, at Grace Evangelical United Brethren Church. When Rev. Pottieger received them, they were in the possession of descendants of the Rev. Neitz. Dr. Cecil P. E. Pottieger, Rev. Pottieger's son, donated HC-28 to the Center for the Evangelical United Brethren Heritage in 1980.

The collection occupies 2 boxes (1 linear foot of shelf space) and consists of two series: Neitz Sermons and Index. The index was prepared by UTS staff members while processing the collection 2007-2008.

There are no restrictions on the use of HC-28.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Henry A. Neitz (Harry), son of the well-known and much honored preacher Solomon Neitz and his wife Susanna, was born at Buffalo, NY on June 16, 1846, and died at Columbia, PA on Sunday morning, January 13, 1901. He was 54 years old. He married Adelia Duel in 1865, and they had seven children, four sons and three daughters.

Harry came to Christ when he was fifteen years old and served his local church as Sunday school class leader and superintendent. He entered the ministry at the age of 21, being licensed at the East Pennsylvania Conference session held at Bethlehem, PA in 1867. He was received into the itinerancy at the same session. In 1868, he was ordained to the office of deacon at the Reading, PA session of the conference, and two years later was ordained an elder.

Rev. Neitz served Evangelical Association congregations at Annville (1867); Fremont (1868); Cressona (1869-1870); Pottsville (1871-1872); and Millersburg (1873-1875). In 1876 he was elected Financial Agent of the education interests of the conference. Unfortunately, ill health caused his retirement from active service in 1877. Returning again to active duties in 1878, he served the congregations at Germantown (1878-1880) and Millersburg (1881-1882).

In 1883, he took another rest from active work. During this retirement from active service, Rev. Neitz bought a controlling interest in a carpet manufacturing business from George W. Kline. Rev. Neitz and Mr. Kline's son (also George W.) formed a partnership under the name Kline and Neitz and continued the business. The corporation was not prosperous and failed in 1893. He was appointed by the East Pennsylvania Conference to serve on the standing committee to audit accounts as a teller on February 27, 1884. He returned to active ministry in the spring of 1897 when he was appointed to serve at Myerstown until the fall of 1898. He served his last appointment, Columbia, until the time of his death.

As a special note, Rev. Neitz served as pastor of the Reedville Church, the original Evangelical church in the Summit Station neighborhood of Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, and he also served as the Evangelical faith pastor of the English Protestant Union Church in Friedensburg, PA. In addition, he was appointed State Chaplain of the Patriotic Order Sons of America.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Series I, <u>Neitz Sermons</u>, consists of 2 boxes. Box 1 contains 65 folders, and Box 2 contains 84 folders. Each folder contains notes for one sermon. The sermons are arranged in the order in which they were received from the donor. As a special note, two sermons are ascribed to the famous preacher Solomon Neitz: Box 1, Folder 8 (Revelation 19:9) and Box 2, Folder 76 (2 Corinthians 7:10-11).

Series II, <u>Index</u>, consists of a single folder that has been placed in the back of Box 2. For each sermon, the index notes the scripture passage and places and dates the sermons were preached, where applicable. It also demarcates the original groupings into which the sermons were rubber-banded by Rev. Pottieger (or by the Neitz family members who gave the sermons to Rev. Pottieger). The meaning of those groupings, if any, is not known. The sermon index was created by Peter Chang and updated by Wheeler Hall.
