INTRODUCTION

This small collection documents the history of Camp St. Marys and, in particular, the September 10, 2001, deconsecration of the Camp St. Marys Tabernacle. All materials in the collection date from 1991-2005. A copy of Arline B. Peckham's book Camp St. Marys: Its Life and Legacy was given anonymously in 2005. A copy of Vol. 15 issue 1 of the *Telescope-Messenger* (Winter 2005) featuring an article about Camp St. Marys has been added to this collection for reference purposes. All other materials were given by Everett H. Aldtadt in 2002.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Camp St. Marys was a UB / EUB/ UMC church camp on the shores of Grand Lake St. Marys in Auglaize County, Ohio. Between 1946 and 1985 Camp St. Marys provided outdoor ministries and recreational opportunities. In 1985 the camp's assets were transferred to the Otterbein Home Board of Trustees for use as a retirement community.
