## Program Plans

United supports three standard program plans: Accelerated, traditional, and balanced. You can find program lengths and the recommended plans for your program later in this guide. Here is the workload expectation while classes are in session:

1. Accelerated = 50 hours a week (4 classes a term)
2. Traditional = 37.5 hours a week (3 classes a term)
3. Balanced = 25 hours a week (2 classes a term)

## Learning Experiences

Most programs support three distinct learning experiences:

1. **On-Campus/Virtual:** Dayton/virtual classes meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Since Dayton classes only meet during the fall and spring terms, be prepared to take hybrid classes in the summer. Below is the on-campus schedule of classes (specific courses and meeting times can be located at the end of this document):

2. **Online:** Online courses meet asynchronously. While there are weekly assignments, online courses provide greater flexibility during the week to complete coursework. The MTS and MA programs can be completed fully online. Students in MDiv are required to come to campus twice in mid-October for the 2 ½ day Contextual Ministry retreat. MACM and MMin students are required to attend the retreat once.
3. **Hybrid:** Distance students who prefer to take courses on site, but who cannot travel multiple times a week to Dayton may choose to take hybrid courses with their virtual or online courses. Hybrid courses are available in the fall and summer terms. Students who choose to take hybrid classes will attend campus for 2 ½ days per hybrid course, or up to a full week for two courses.
